The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey will be open from **Monday 7 August to Friday 8 September 2023**.

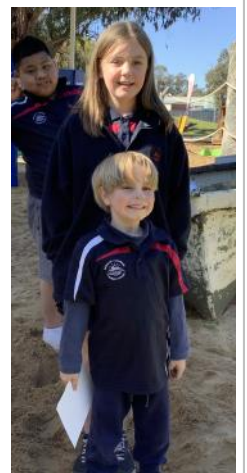
The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the survey period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese.

OSHC Vacation Care Program During Term 3 Holiday Break

We are so lucky this term to be able to offer Vacation Care during the next school holiday period. A big thank you to Cherylee and Rayner for their efforts in providing this program. Below are some details about the program. If you have any other questions or would like to make a booking please let the school know.

What are the operating days and hours?

The program will be operating:

First week - Monday, Wednesday and Friday - 8am to 6pm.

Second week - Monday and Wednesday - 8am to 6pm. (*Friday is the Grand Final public holiday.*)

How many staff members will be carrying out the program?

There will be two qualified and enthusiastic staff, Cherylee and Rayner on duty for the duration of the program.

What is the cost?

The cost is \$100 per child per day. This sounds a lot, however, most families are entitled to 90% CCS funding so the out of pocket cost for families is only \$10 per child for a whole day of care.

The cost is also for the whole day, if children only come for one or two activities they will still be charged the one flat fee of \$100 (or out of pocket cost of approximately \$10).

Are snacks and lunches included?

Yes, the program provides all snacks and lunches.

Typical snacks include: muffins, loaded crackers, fruit, pikelets, raw vegetables, spaghetti 'n' cheese bowls, popcorn, pastry twists, garlic cheese fingers.

Typical lunches include: salad sandwiches, pasta bowls, hot dogs, hot chips, pizzas.

How to make a booking?

Children will need to be enrolled in SmartCentral as per our normal OSHC program procedure. Most children are already enrolled in the program so only children who haven't attended our afternoon OSHC would need to enrol.

If families are wishing to claim CCS funding they must have approval before the start of the school holidays.

At this stage our daily attendance is limited to 15 children per day, however, if we have a lot of interest in the program we can arrange for our licence capacity to be increased.

Can I book my children in on the day of the program (casual booking)?

No. As this is our first time in running this program we will only be accepting pre-booked bookings. The final day for families to make a booking into our Vacation Care program will be Tuesday 12th of September. No further bookings can be made after that date.

I already have a regular booking for OSHC afternoon care do I still need to make a booking for Vacation Care?

Yes. Over the school holiday break OSHC afternoon care does not operate so any bookings in that program stop and will restart at the beginning of term 4.

The Vacation Care program is a separate program offered by the school through its Outside of School Hours Care program. If you would like your child to attend Vacation Care during the school holiday break you will need to contact the school to make a booking.

What if I made a booking but my child cannot attend due to sickness?

In short, you will still be charged the daily \$100 fee, which would be approximately \$10 out of pocket expenses for families.

Part of CCS funding is that they allow children to be absent for a total of 42 days care before families have to pay the full amount. If your child is booked into the program and they are sick families should contact the school or educator to notify them of the absence. The child will be marked absent on the roll and will still incur the full fee of \$100, however, families will only be out of pocket for the gap amount - which may be as low as \$10.00 depending on their CCS entitlement.

Can children who are not enrolled at the school attend the program?

Yes, we welcome children from 5 years to 12 years of age to enrol in this fabulous program. Children will need to be enrolled in SmartCentral and have approved CCS funding - if applicable.

Will my child need to bring anything on the day?

No, everything is supplied. They can bring their own water bottle if they choose to. On days when children will be here to watch a movie they can bring a pillow or blanket if they choose to. We have three themed days during the program, crazy hat day, pj day and wackiest look day, on these days children can come in the appropriate theme. However, this is only optional.

What is the schedule for the program?

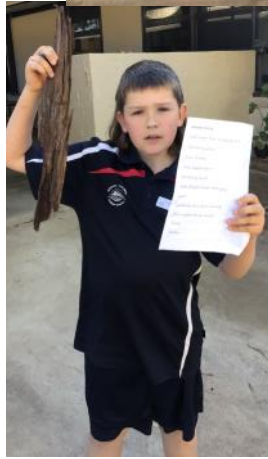
