# Outside of School Hours Care (OSHC) Program

## Update

Firstly, we would like to thank all the families who support our wonderful program.

Our OSHC program has been running for the past 2 1/2 years and has proved to be a great help to families and to provide children with activities outside of school hours.

Originally, our school received a grant to set up and run the program, however, the grant expires at the end of this year. This means going forward the program will have to generate enough funds to cover staff wages, cost of materials, food and software costs. **Therefore, from the beginning of Term 4 - Monday 7th of October, we will be increasing the cost of our OSHC to \$30 per session per child.**

Families who are registered for CCS through Centrelink will still only be charged the gap amount, which will increase to as little as approximately \$4.36 per child per session. Currently, families who receive CCS funding pay as little as \$2.18 per child per session.

By increasing our session rate we are also bringing our program in line with other programs running in the Mildura/Red Cliffs area.

The program will still continue to offer the great service and activities we have been offering with our amazing staff, Cherylee and Sheena.

**Visit from the Red Cliffs Historical Society** - we were lucky last week to have a visit from Bob and Helen from the Red Cliffs Historical Society. They spent time in each classroom giving a presentation and showing items that were used in the past. Thank you Bob and Helen for your informative and interesting visit, hopefully we can do it again soon.

From 3-4-5 Classroom:

Mr. Pav's grade 3-4-5 class had a visit from Bob Walton and Helen from the Red Cliffs Historical Society on Thursday 8th of August.

The Nangiloc/Colignan students were captivated with the power point presentation and history session of how items Bob brought in for the students to examine were used, what they were used for and how the items had changed over time.

Students then wrote about these items and described how they contributed to general day to day duties such as cooking, preparing meals, cleaning, making candles for a light source and making hot water for drinking tea.

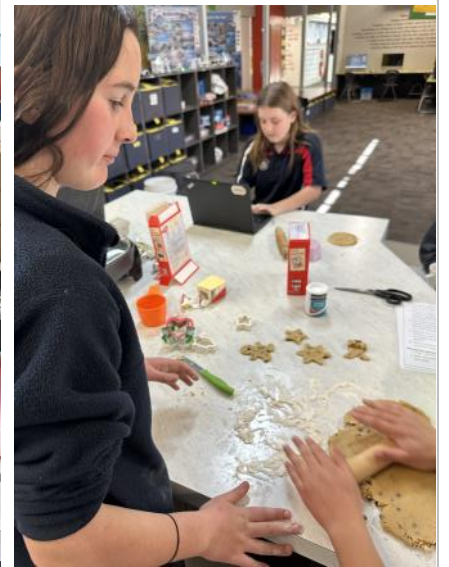
Thank you Bob and Helen for such an enjoyable and informative and valuable learning lesson.
