Outside of School Hours Care (OSHC) Program

Update

Firstly, we would like to thank all the families who support our wonderful program.

Our OSHC program has been running for the past 2 1/2 years and has proved to be a great help to families and to provide children with activities outside of school hours.

Originally, our school received a grant to set up and run the program, however, the grant expires at the end of this year. This means going forward the program will have to generate enough funds to cover staff wages, cost of materials, food and software costs. Therefore, from the beginning of Term 4 - Monday 7th of October, we will be increasing the cost of our OSHC to \$30 per session per child.

Families who are registered for CCS through Centrelink will still only be charged the gap mount, which will increase to as little as approximately \$4.36 per child per session. Currently, families who receive CCS funding pay as little as \$2.18 per child per session.

By increasing our session rate we are also bringing our program in line with other programs running in the Mildura/Red Cliffs area.

The program will still continue to offer the great service and activities we have been offering with our amazing staff, Cherylee and Sheena.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE 2024 SCHOOL CAMP

This year our whole school camp is at Murray Life Adventures Camp between **Wednesday 16th October 2024 to Friday 18th October 2024**. There is no cost to families for this camp, the school is covering all costs.






