We kindly ask parents/carers to ensure their children come to school with a hat to wear.

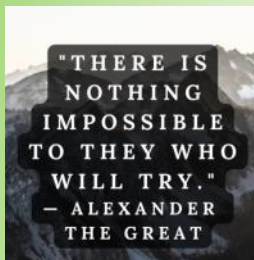

School Saving Bonus - we are up to the next stage of the \$400 school saving bonus (SSB).

Please note, that families do not have to make any decisions at this stage of the process about allocating any funds. The program does not close until Monday 30.6.25.

The following is some points of interest about the program:-

- Schools will receive a \$400 School Saving Bonus for all students into the Department's School Saving Bonus bank account on Friday 22.11.24.
- Between Tuesday 26.11.24 and Thursday 28.11.24 parents and carers will receive an email from the Department with their unique code for each child.
- Families with more than 1 child will receive multiple emails with unique codes for each child.
- Families can choose how to spend the \$400. However, we would like to make the following suggestion:
As usual we are planning on a whole school camp in 2025 and this money can be used to supplement or pay in full camp costs in 2025, however, if you choose to allocate the funds elsewhere the responsibility for paying for camp will rest with the family.
- Parents and carers can allocate their child's bonus to another sibling.
- The system runs from 26.11.24 to 30.6.25. Allocation of funds can be made at any time up until 30.6.25.

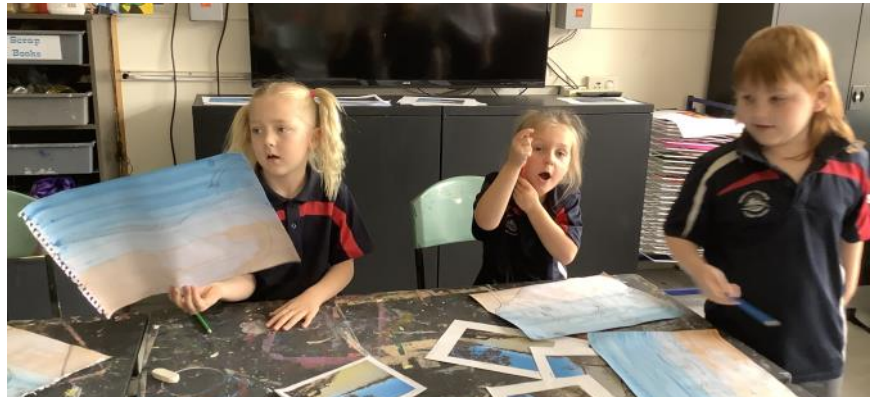

We would like to say a BIG THANK YOU to Mrs Hicks for visiting our school and showing us how to plant seedling and how to look after them.

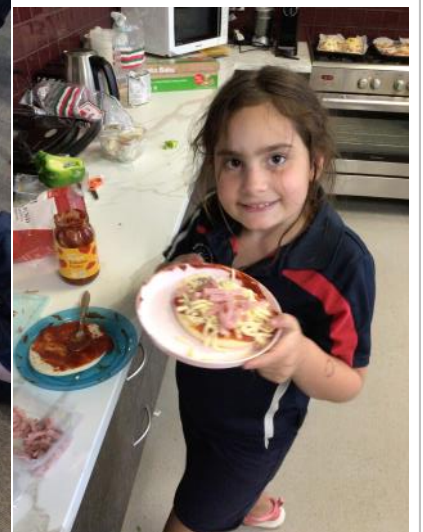
